

TO ALL BIDDERS BIDDING ON THE ABOVE PROJECT:

The Bid and Contract Documents of the *2019 Neighborhood Street Improvement Project* is revised as follows. Addendum No. 2 becomes a part of the Contract Document, and as indicated, the bidder shall acknowledge receipt thereof.

- I. The following are revisions to the Bid Schedule:
 - a. Delete "BID SCHEDULES" in its entirety and replace with "BID SCHEDULES" attached to this Addendum. Changes from included in Addendum 1 are heightened in yellow, new changes are highlighted in green.
 - b. Please note that Bid Items 9 thru 13 each includes the installation of AC. For example, the 2" Wedge Grind includes the grinding and installation of pavement for the square footage shown on the bid list.

Note: The City reserves the right to increase or decrease quantities by 25%, as described in Section 4-1.05 "Changes and Extra Work" of the Caltrans Standard Specifications.

Note: The estimate of construction quantities set forth herein is approximate only, being given as a basis for the comparison of bids. The City does not expressly or by implication agree that the actual amount of work will correspond therewith, and reserves the right to change the amount of any class or portion of the work or to omit portions of the work as may be deemed necessary or expedient by the Engineer in accordance with Section 4-1.05, "Changes and Extra Work," of the Standard Specifications. All bids will be compared on the basis of the Engineer's Estimate of quantities of the work to be done. The undersigned declares, by their signature to this proposal, that the bidder has checked carefully all of the above figures and understands that the City shall not be responsible for any errors or omissions on the part of the undersigned in making up this bid.

Bids are required for the entire work. The amount of the bid for comparison purposes will be the total of all items. The total of unit basis items will be determined by extension of the item unit price bid on the basis of the estimated quantity set forth for the item.

The bidder shall set forth each item of work, in clearly legible figures, an item unit price and a total for the item in the respective spaces provided for this purpose. In the case of unit basis items, the amount set forth under the "Total" column shall be the extension of the item price bid on the basis of the estimated quantity for the item.

In case of discrepancy between the item unit price and the total set forth for the item, the item unit price shall prevail, provided, however, if the amount set forth as an item price is ambiguous, unintelligible or uncertain for any cause, or is omitted, or in the case of unit basis items, is the same amount as the entry in the "Total" column, then the amount set forth in the "Total" column

for the item shall prevail in accordance with the following:

1. As to lump sum items, the amount set forth in the "Total" column shall be the item price.
2. As to unit basis items, the amount set forth in the "Total" column shall be divided by the estimated quantity for the item and the price thus obtained shall be the item price.

If this Proposal shall be accepted and the undersigned should fail to execute the contract with the City as aforesaid or should fail to provide the "Faithful Performance" Surety Bond in the sum of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract amount, the "Labor and Material Payment" Surety Bond in the sum of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract amount, proof of insurance covering Public Liability and Property Damage in amounts satisfactory to the City Attorney, proof of Workmen's Compensation Insurance in the amount and form prescribed by the State of California, within ten (10) days (not counting Sundays and legal holidays) after the date of City's notice to the bidder of the contract award, the City may, at its option, determine that the bidder has abandoned the Contract, thereupon this Proposal and the acceptance thereof shall be null and void, and the forfeiture of any security accompanying this Proposal shall operate and the same shall become the property of the City of Monte Sereno, State of California.

Accompanying this Proposal is _____
(insert the words "Cashier's Check", "Certified Check", or "Bidder's Bond", as the case may be, made out to the City of Monte Sereno), in amount equal to at least ten percent (10%) of the total bid.

Bidders must, upon request, furnish evidence of their financial responsibility and ability to perform the work herein described.

The Bidder agrees to accept as full payment for the construction of the Project the amount computed in accordance with the bid schedule prices, which include all costs for labor, materials, tools, equipment, services, taxes, insurance, overhead, profit, warranty performance and all other costs necessary to perform the work in accordance with the Contract Documents. Bid prices shall be shown in figures for individual item totals and in both words and figures for the total bid. In case of discrepancy between words and figures for total amount, the words shall prevail. If erasures or other changes appear on this proposal, each such erasure or change must be initialed by the person signing the bid.

On all bid items for which bids are to be received on a unit price basis, the unit price for all items bid shall be shown, as well as the extended price (unit price multiplied by the number of units shown on the proposal form) for each bid item bid. In the case of any discrepancy between the extended price for any bid item bid, the unit price multiplied by the number of units shall prevail. In the event of any discrepancy between the total contract amount and the sum of the extended prices of all items, the sum of the extended prices of all items shall prevail.

Any federal, state or local tax payable on articles to be furnished shall be included in the prices bid and shall be paid by the Contractor. The City is exempt from federal excise tax and will provide a certificate of exemption to Contractor upon request.

The City reserves the right to reject any and all proposals and/or waive any irregularity in any proposal received.

Unless otherwise required by law, no bidder may withdraw his proposal for a period of ninety (90) calendar days after the date set for receipt thereof.

BASIS OF AWARD

The award, if made, will be awarded to the responsible bidder submitting the lowest Grand Total Base Bid. In accordance with the contract documents and other applicable law, the City may add or deduct items of work after the lowest responsible bidder is determined.
